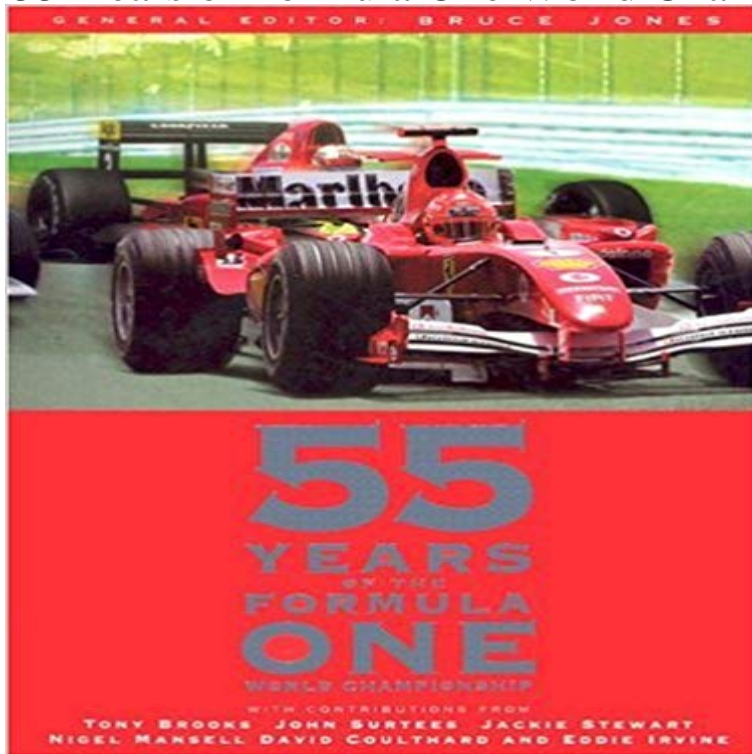


55 Years of Formula One World Championship
