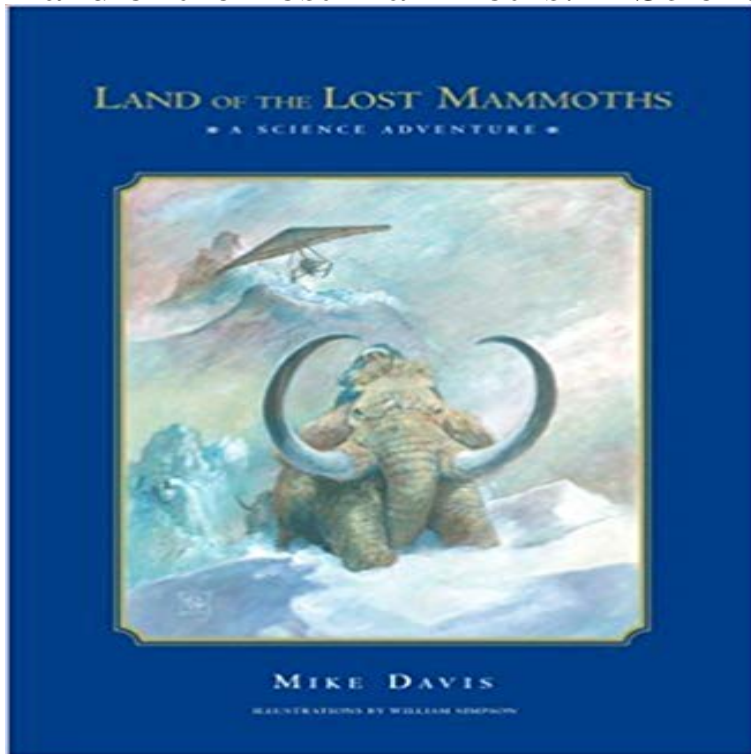


Land of the Lost Mammoths: A Science Adventure
