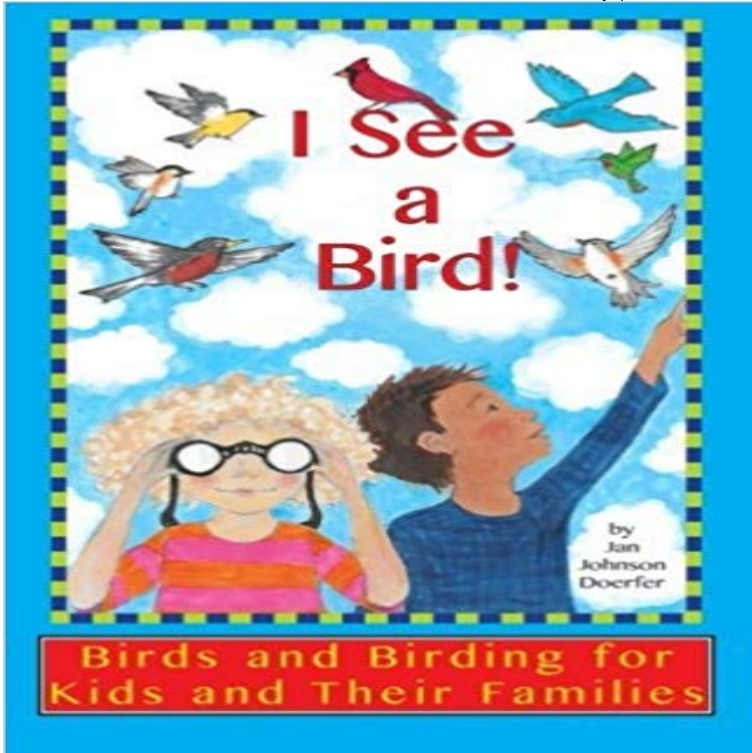


I See a Bird!: Birds and Birding for Kids and Their Families
