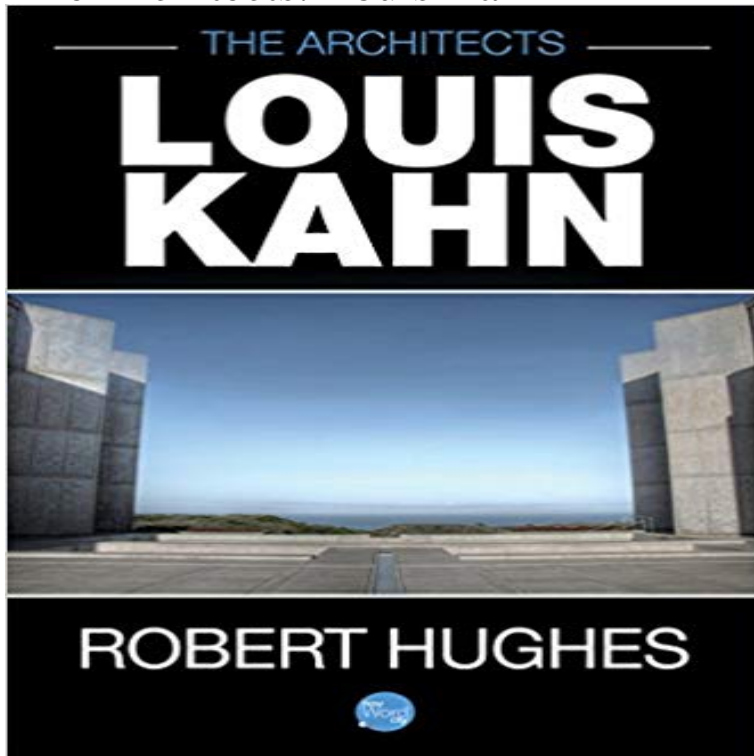


## The Architects: Louis Kahn
