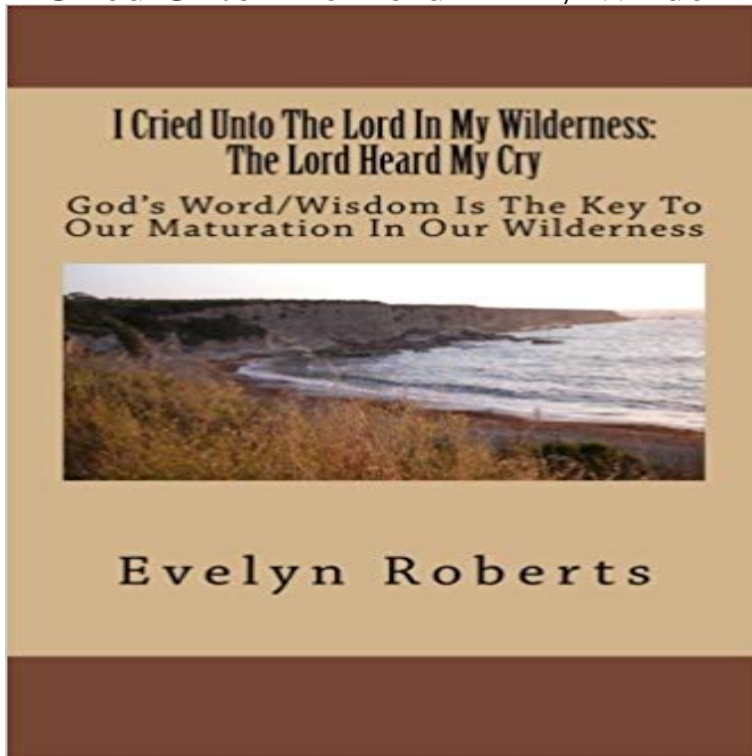


# I Cried Unto The Lord In My Wilderness: The Lord Heard My Cry
