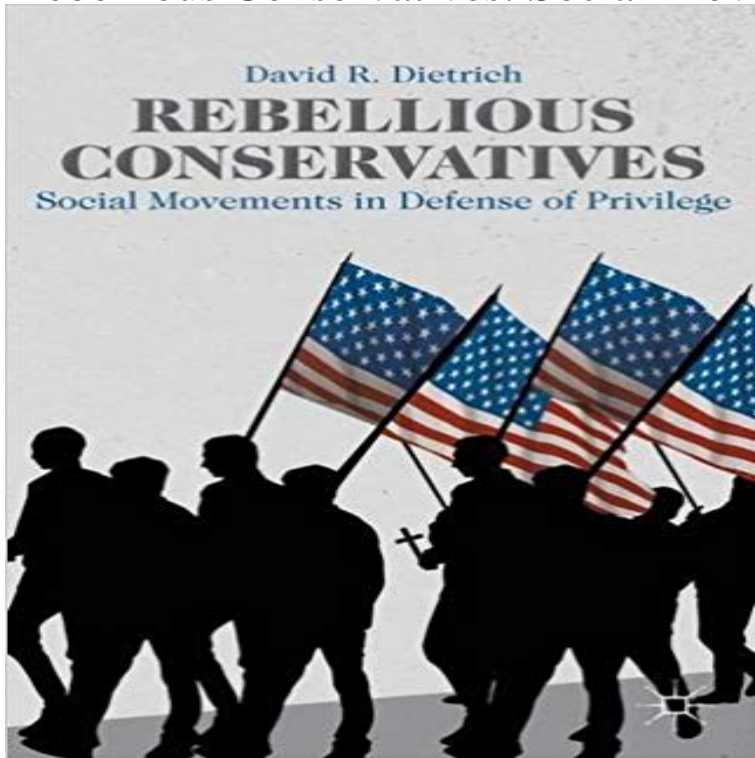


Rebellious Conservatives: Social Movements in Defense of Privilege
