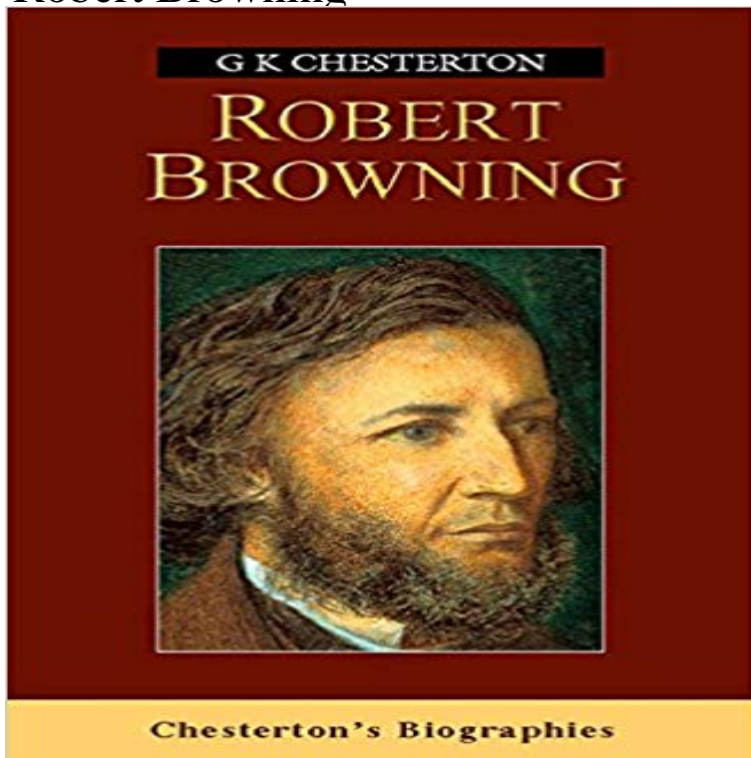


Robert Browning
