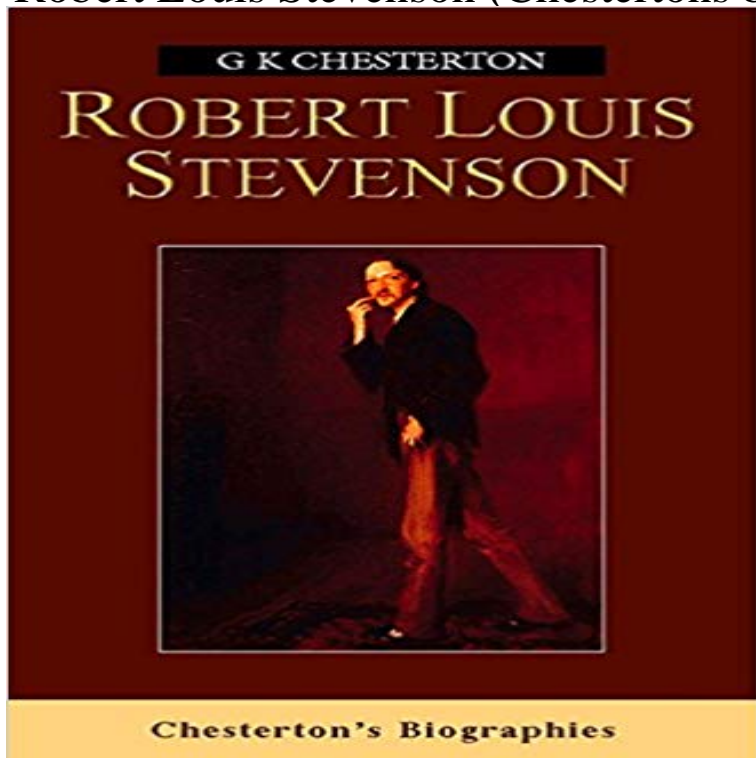


Robert Louis Stevenson (Chestertons biographies)
