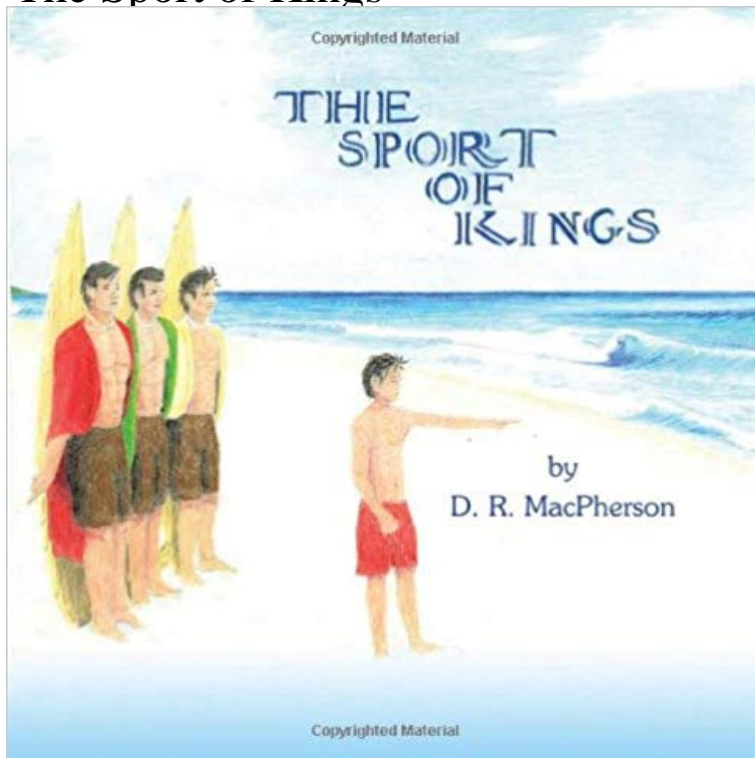


The Sport of Kings
