The Index, compiled by Mr. Grove, is intended to contain an exhaustive statement of the occurrences of every geographical name in the English version of the Old and New Testaments and the Apocrypha, with its original in Hebrew or Greek, and the modern name of its site, whether known or only conjectured. In all cases, what may be regarded as certain is distinguished from what is uncertain. The main purpose of the Notes is to explain the reasons for assigning their places in the Maps to the more important of those names which cannot be identified on clear and simple grounds of tradition, and to give short accounts of the chief controversies in the Geography and Topography of the Bible.
