


## 45 Years 45 Lives: A real story of tragedy, love, determination, helplessness, happiness, and finally peace in ones heart

Born in a small English town in Lancashire in the early 60s, David is a wanderer at heart. Narrated in his own words, 45 Years, 45 Lives is the story of his explorations of his soul as much as of the world around him. David's life is a series of crossroads, and a series of reinventions. First a teenage David Bowie wannabe, then a waiter, a butler, a physiotherapist, TV presenter, property developer, and now a writer at the age of 45, David traverses many roles and many lives. Yet, this isn't just a story about David. This is also the story of his mother, a constant pillar of support throughout his turbulent journey. This is the story of Brian and his capacity for infinite love. This is the story of Ahmed, the illegal Algerian immigrant who brings hope into David's dark life. And this is the story of Colin, the over-the-top gay rights activist whose personal struggles become the inspiration behind this book.
